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Bross Bagels

Good bagels are hard to source in the UK, frustratingly hard. Yes, New York reigns supreme when it comes to bagels, but Montreal bagels have their own charm - they're sweeter and thinner. Bross Bagels make their own the traditional way, broiling them.
